# PARKING RULES AND REGULATIONS

## PERMANENT PARKING STICKERS

1. Up to two permanent parking stickers (maximum) may be issued for each mooring space. The only exception is when a space is occupied by a vessel containing more than one dwelling unit (duplex, triplex), and additional two stickers per each additional dwelling may be issued.
2. Permanent stickers may be issued upon receipt of:
  - a. A copy of the current vehicle registration
  - b. Year, make, model and license number of vehicle to which sticker will be attached.
  - c. Current telephone contact information.
3. The WPH permit number must appear on the sticker or the sticker will not be valid. If you obtain a sticker for a new car, please return the old sticker and a new pre-numbered permit will be issued to you.
4. The sticker must be placed on the rear bumper of your vehicle or the sticker will not be valid.
5. Stickers are color-coded and parking is restricted between docks. You must park in your own dock lot or the sticker will not be valid. However, the overflow for the A dock lot will be permitted to park in the Issaquah lot only.

## GUEST PASSES

1. Guest passes are to be used for guests only and may not be used to park additional cars of residents.
2. Passes will be valid for one overnight use only.
3. Passes must be filled out in ink and may not be altered in any way or the pass will not be valid.
4. Passes are color-coded and parking is restricted between the docks. Your guest must park in your dock lot or the pass will not be valid. However, the overflow for the A dock lot will be permitted to park in the Issaquah lot only.

## GENERAL RULES

1. Cars parked in violation of these rules may be towed at any time, day or night, seven days per week.
2. A fifteen-minute grace period will be allowed before removing the vehicle from the lot.
3. Vehicles parked in areas marked "NO PARKING, TOWAWAY" are subject to towing at any time with no grace period.
4. Abandoned, stored or inoperable vehicles are prohibited. Any vehicle that has not moved in ten days will be posted and towed.
5. Residents going on vacation must notify the WPH Office to avoid being towed.
6. Vehicles must not be repaired or dismantled on the WPH lots.
7. No buses, campers, trailers or live-in vehicles are permitted without prior consent from the WPH Office.
8. Vehicles parked on WPH property are parked at the owner's risk. The Harbor takes no responsibility for any damaged, lost or stolen vehicles or property.
9. Vehicles towed from Waldo Point Harbor may be retrieved from Redwood Towing (456-8943) or from other towing companies that WPH may designate from time to time.
